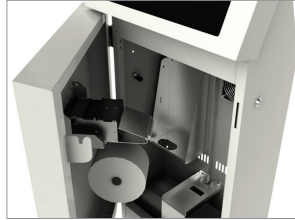

The small footprint and robust features makes the California perfectly suited for all solutions.

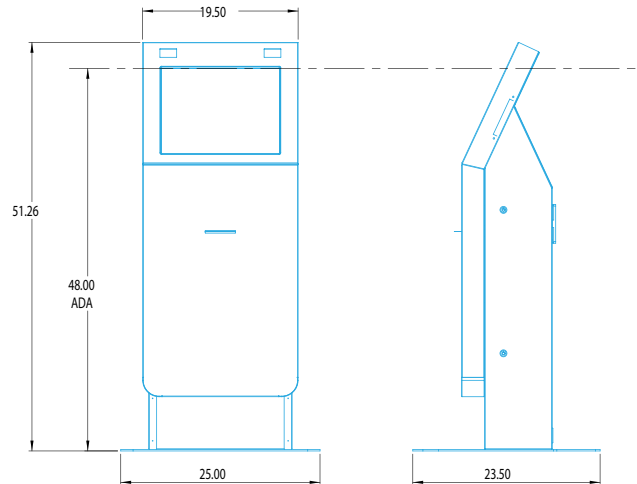
